Bust A Move

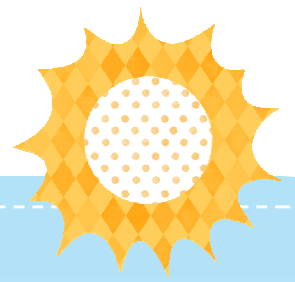

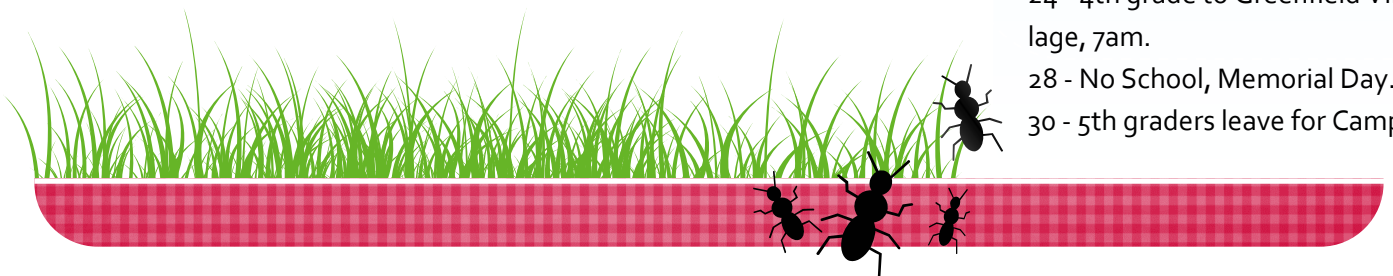
